Opera! Mozart's *The Marriage of Figaro* and *The Magic Flute* are both romantic comedies that follow the trials and adventures of overcoming obstacles.

In *Figaro*, two servants, Figaro and Susanna must connive to prevent their master, Count Almaviva, from seducing her. There are numerous complications involving others with desire or jealousy, but throughout, the music enlivens the buffoonery.

The Magic Flute is more of a coming-of-age story. Two men, one comic and one sincere, see beyond illusions and seductions to win true love.
